Notes

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss bidding of the Roanoke Island Aquarium Elevator Renovation.

Bidders were directed to the Project Manual for complete information on the construction contract and bidding requirements. Several points were emphasized:

- 1. A 5% Bid Bond is required and bidders should use the NC State Construction Office Form. Form is attached to this email.
- 2. All Minority Business Participation Affidavits are required to be filled out unless the project is under \$300,000 in which case only the Appendix E is required.
- 3. The bid opening will be in the Roanoke Island Aquarium Conference Room at 2:00pm on May 11. Bidders do not need to be present, but a completed sealed bid must be in the conference room by the bid deadline.

The lead time for elevator parts is a concern which was the reason for extending the construction time to 150 days in Addendum 1. The elevator subcontractor cautioned that even with the extension, there may be a need to extend construction time. It was agreed that this would be resolved during construction by a no cost Change Order. Bidders were reminded that there are \$500 per day liquidated damages for project completion beyond the construction time and that considerable coordination with Aquarium staff will be required to limit elevator down time.

The elevator subcontractor expressed concern that the specified elevator (a twin-post model) may require relocating the existing door openings. This is not accounted for in the drawings and specifications and would be a change order which the Owner would like to avoid. The elevator subcontractor measured the existing shaft and openings to find out if the specified model was able to be installed without moving the openings. The other option is to replace the elevator with the same type as the existing (a single-post model). According to the subcontractor, the twin-post model would be more stable and reliable, but more expensive. As an option, the Owner suggested to have an alternate bid to install a single-post model to avoid having to move the door openings. An alternate bid will be addressed through a bid addendum.

The drain line from the trench drain was drawn correctly on the plumbing plan, and the architectural plan but incorrectly on the architectural section. Please make note of this. The trench drain will terminate into the existing second floor floor drain system.

I have received and approved a bid substitution to provide an aluminum elevator pit elevator instead of steel. See attached. Containment of construction activity dust will be a priority on this project for the safety of staff and aquatic exhibits. The location of the work is very close to the main existing tank and dust must not pollute the environment. Containment walls and exhaust devices will need to be provided by the contractor as required.
