Summary of Discussion

- 1. Michael Younts thanked everyone for their interest in the project and attendance at the pre-bid meeting.
- 2. Michael Younts introduced of Wake County Public School System (WCPSS) Owner team and Design Team (Dewberry Engineers Inc.):
 - a. Billy Massengill (WCPSS) will be the primary Owner Representative
 - b. Michael Younts (Dewberry Engineers Inc) will be the primary Design Team Representative.
- 3. Bid Document Access: Michael Younts asked if everyone was able to access the bid documents.
- 4. Project Scope of Work:
 - a. The removal/replacement of the existing fire alarm system with a Voice EVAC fire alarm system.

5. School Schedule:

- a. This is a single track year-round school (follows Track 4 schedule). Work will be scheduled after school and on weekends and during school breaks (track-out) and teacher workdays.
