- c. Contract Time shall be sixty (60) calendar days from date of Notice to Proceed.
- d. Liquidated damages are set at \$250.00 per calendar day for work not accomplished beyond the date of substantial completion.
- e. Contractor Five (5) Year Warranty for waterproofing repairs.

# 6. Minority Business Guidelines:
