(2) Entry doors to the new enlarged Conference Room will be removed and infilled with gypsum walls. All finishes will be updated including carpet, paint, trim, and wall base. The existing ceiling grid system of Conference #359 will be retained, if possible, and continued with new grid system into the former Storage #358A area. New ACT will be installed throughout the ceiling grid system. Modifications to lighting, electrical, and HVAC will be included.
